George Barber decided to dedicate a portion of his dairy industry fortune showcasing the world's largest collection of motorcycles (1,600), including super

rare steam-powered bicycles dating from the 1860s. Barber is also home to <u>The</u> <u>Porsche Track Experience</u>; the world's largest factory sponsored driving school.

Barber hosts the annual <u>IndyCar Honda Grand Prix of Alabama</u> and sponsors the Annual Barber Vintage Festival, attracting more than 80,000 participants.
